Since then, he has co-founded many dance crews as well as co-produced shows such as "InnerActions", which was featured in the Georgetown National Institutes in Washington DC. In his 9th year with Pacific Arts Complex, David is focused on creating a lasting impact on the dance community by training future teachers and fostering leadership among rising choreographers.
